The Opportunity

As the Health Link Care Navigator, you will be responsible for collaborating with Health Link partners to identify and link complex clients (Top 5% of the users of the health care system) with health, social and community services and other programs. This position also aids in the facilitation and development of coordinated care plans with care partners and providers; organizes and facilitates care conferences; monitors clients' needs; conducts surveys; identify and eliminate duplicate services being provided; and evaluates defined outcome measures.

What you will do:

- Arrange, coordinate, and ensure the effectiveness of the services being provided to clients with multiple medical and/or socially complex needs
- Communicate with clients to explain the Health Link approach to care, schedule meetings and case conferences, complete assessments/reviews, and maintain regular contact with clients and care partners
- Facilitate communication and collaboration with members of the Health Link Care Team, the clients, and their caregivers to optimize outcomes and to ensure the care plans' goals are met
