The Opportunity

Reporting to the Activities Manager, the Restorative Aide implements restorative programs to assist and support residents to restore, maintain or improve activities of daily living and psychosocial/mental functioning.

What you will do:

- Implement and assist in evaluating both individual and group restorative programs based on assessed needs of individual residents as assigned by the Manager and Registered Staff.
- Transport residents to and from programs
- Assist with feeding residents during mealtimes
- Monitor the behavior and condition of residents during restorative programs, reporting any significant changes to the Manager and registered staff as appropriate.

What you will need:

- Graduate of a two (2) year college program in Kinesiology, Gerontology or related program
- Completion of Restorative Care Certificate (3 day course)
 - Previous experience working with seniors in restorative programs, preferably in LTC, would be an asset plus on-the-job orientation and training of up to 1 month
 - Completed police record check, including vulnerable sector screening
