Maintenance Helper



This role is responsible for assisting Maintenance team with landscaping and general maintenance at the Pines Long Term Care Home. This summer student job will work a 35-hour work week, some weekends and evenings may be required. Students should be available to begin work the first week of May and continue work through to the end of August.

COVID safety protocols are in place for all employees of the Pines Long Term Care Home.

You will gain four months of hands-on experience, open doors and build transferable skills for your future career.

Responsibilities of the Maintenance Helper will include, but not be limited to:

- Performs grounds maintenance, which may include: weeding, watering flower beds and planters, general upkeep of the grounds, picking up debris, planting shrubs and flowers and adding mulch;
- Assists other maintenance department employees required;
- Performing building maintenance, which may include painting of resident rooms, refinishing outdoor furniture, improving the general appearance of the facility;
