## The Opportunity

Reporting to the Director of Care, the Social Worker will work as part of an interdisciplinary team to provide social work services to residents and their family members. They will plan, organize, implement and assess programs and services to enhance the quality of life in the long term care home.

### What You Will Do:

- Review resident admissions and referrals for further assessment; complete referral data and information to support and guide resident care plan when required.
- Facilitate meetings with residents and stakeholders to determine resident care goals, interventions related to mental wellness, discharge and/or palliative planning, and case management in complex situations.
- Assist in identifying the learning needs of staff related to support programs and collaborate to design overall learning strategies and interventions.
