The COVID Rapid Test Provider is responsible for conducting and analyzing the results of COVID 19 Rapid antigen testing.

What you will do:

- Maintain strict personal adherence to infection prevention and control measures and procedures
- Administer COVID-19 point of care Rapid Antigen nasal swab (training provided) to staff, students, caregivers, contractors and visitors to the LTC Home
- Guide staff, students, caregivers, contractors and visitors to maintain adherence to infection prevention and control measures and procedures
- Interpret and accurately record testing results

What you will need:

- Education in a health-related discipline with knowledge of nasal oropharyngeal anatomy
- Basic knowledge of swab collection and/or COVID-19 testing procedures as well as signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- Experience in COVID screening/Rapid swab specimen collection preferred
- Current CPR Certificate
- Knowledge of infection prevention and control procedures
- Completed police record check, including vulnerable sector screening
