

Coordinated Care Planning

What is a Coordinated Care Plan?

A plan for **your care** that is created with you and your family (as per your direction) and involves all the members of your health care team.

What's involved?

Your care team will meet with you and your family to design a care plan that meets **your specific needs and goals**.

After the meeting you will have:

- An individualized, coordinated plan focused on your goals
- Care providers who ensure the plan is being followed
- Support to make sure you are taking the right medication
- A care provider that you can call—someone who knows you, is familiar with your situation and can help




Why is your consent needed?

To create a plan to improve your care, some information may need to be shared by your care team in order to:

- Determine eligibility for certain services
- Provide services
- Evaluate the services provided
- Plan Programs
