The Engineering and Public Works department is currently looking for a:  
**Permanent, Full-time Engineering Design Technologist 2**

This role is Responsible for the design and preparation of plans, specifications and approvals, as required, for in-house environmental and transportation capital projects with an emphasis on environmental projects. It also assists with the preparation and review of applications under the transfer program of the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change. This job will work a 35-hour work week, Monday to Friday.

Responsibilities of the Engineering Design Technologist 2 will include, but not be limited to:

- Obtain necessary preparatory design information from survey data, utility companies, area municipalities, manufacturers' publications, etc. Obtain the services of geotechnical and other specialists where necessary for capital environmental and infrastructure programs.
- Prepare plans and tender documents using computer aided design and drafting software and standard office applications software and recommend changes during construction as required.
- Ensure that designs comply with all applicable laws, standards and guidelines.
- Provide estimates of project costs for capital budgeting and pre-tender reviews.
- Provide liaison and coordination between operations, project inspectors, contractors and utility companies.
- Interprets contract plans and specifications for various stakeholders

The skills, experience and qualifications we are seeking for this job include:

- Graduate of a three year community college program in civil engineering at the Technologist level or equivalent; EIT would be desirable
- Member (technologist) in good standing with OACETT (Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists)
- Four to five years directly related experience.

We would expect that your strengths will include strong technological proficiency with thorough knowledge of all applicable legislation, standards and guidelines. Your proven communication and organizational skills will allow you to balance between working collaboratively with a team and as an independent contributor with minimal supervision.
