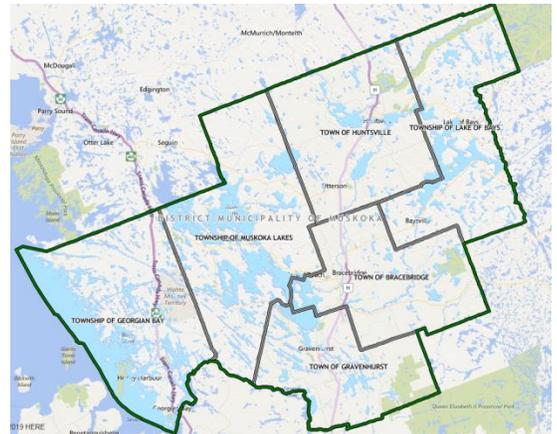
- Produce and maintain corporate Geographic Information Systems including script writing, database creation, ongoing maintenance and editing of corporate and Area Municipality GIS layers.
- Deliver GIS services and training for Muskoka and Area Municipal staff, as required, including assistance to users regarding how to query and extract information from databases.
- Research, analyze, create and report on new techniques, technologies, approaches and GIS solutions to address corporate or Area needs.
- Provide information to Muskoka staff, Area Municipalities and general public regarding GIS mapping and data in accordance with any data sharing agreements or other requirements.
- Assist in maintaining the corporate GIS web mapping application and provide training for its use where requested.
- Create and update GIS procedural manuals, guidelines and metadata.
- Provide support, assistance and backup for the GIS Project Coordinator and the Technician I (911) where required.

Our GIS team develops and maintains spatial information for mapping and data analysis purposes to support District initiatives, and to provide the public with access to important geographical information.
