The District of Muskoka is seeking a professional and experienced Project Manager to join our Water and Wastewater team within the Engineering and Public Works department.

Reporting to the Director, Water and Wastewater Services, the Project Manager is responsible for the design and project management of municipal infrastructure projects with a focus on linear and vertical infrastructure and water and wastewater systems, including water storage and distribution systems, wastewater collection and disposal systems, and treatment systems. This role may also assist in the design and project management of other projects in the Engineering & Public Works (EPW) department of the District, such as roads and/ or waste management.

Responsibilities included, but are not limited to:

- Manage all stages of engineering projects to ensure that costs are controlled to budget and schedule.
- Manage internal or external design teams to ensure that District standards and project objectives are met.
- Administer consultant and construction contracts including preparation of procurement documents, evaluation of proposals, contract management, regulatory approval and monitoring through the construction stage to completion.
- Perform inspections of existing infrastructure for the purpose of developing the project scope of work and updating the District Asset Management Plan.
- Provide engineering design and certification of infrastructure projects.
- Review and approve design plans, specifications and contract documents prepared by consultants.
- Assist in the compilation of the capital budget and ten year capital forecast.
- Prepare reports to the Engineering & Public Works Committee and make presentations as required.

The District is responsible for operating and maintaining all municipal water and wastewater systems, including lagoons, throughout Muskoka.
