With the upcoming summer season, we have an opportunity available for a temporary full-time temporary full-time **Seasonal Roads & Traffic Maintenance Labourer** (up to 6 months). This role is responsible for providing support to the Roads and Traffic crews with respect to maintenance of District roads and infrastructure.

This job will work a 40-hour work week, Monday to Friday.

Responsibilities of the Seasonal – Roads & Traffic Maintenance Labourer will include, but not be limited to:

- Install, inspect and maintain all private and highway traffic signs on Muskoka roads, including the preparation and maintenance of complete records.
- Assist with the set-up, installation, and removal of electronic traffic counting devices and download data collected for use internally.
- Assist with annual contract work in the field
- Complete general maintenance along Muskoka road allowances (i.e. guiderail maintenance grass cutting, tree trimming, sign straightening, etc.)
- Participate in the annual spring bridge cleaning program.
- Identify and resolve safety issues in the field.
- Work safely and in compliance with relevant statutes and regulations and within the safe work procedures and directives as established by the District; and
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

The skills, experience and qualifications we are seeking for this job include:

- Completion of Grade 12 education, at minimum
- One to two years' experience in a related field
- Completion of the Chainsaw Operator course
- Must have a valid Ontario driver's license, in good standing.

We would expect that your strengths will include ability to take direction from multiple parties and have good interpersonal skills. An understanding of Minimum Maintenance Standards and basic computer skills will serve you well in this role.
