Are you interested in learning about how roadways are built and maintained? Every year, the District offers summer employment to students registered in post-secondary education and this year the Engineering and Public Works department is hiring:

General Labourers – Roads and Traffic (Student)



This role assists with the road maintenance operations and programs on Muskoka roads. This summer student job will work a 40-hour work week. Some weekend work may be required.

Students should be available to begin work the first week of May and continue work through to the end of August. COVID safety protocols are in place for these jobs.

You will gain four months of hands-on experience, open doors and build transferable skills for your future career.

Responsibilities of the General Labourers – Roads and Traffic will include, but not be limited to:

- General maintenance along Muskoka road allowances (i.e. raking around guide rails, weed whacking, tree trimming, sign straightening, etc.)
- Taking gravel tickets and emulsion tickets on various contracts and keeping a running total.
- Participating with Traffic crews by conducting traffic control flagging duties.

The skills, experience and qualifications we are seeking for this job include:

- Students must be enrolled in full-time post-secondary studies for the following school year.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to work outdoors and perform manual labour.
- A valid Ontario Driver's License (minimum G2) is required for this role as you will be driving District vehicles.
