### Water and Wastewater Operations Students



This role assists our licensed water and wastewater operators with our daily operations, grounds keeping and general maintenance.

This summer student job will work a 40-hour work week. Students should be available to begin work the first week of May and continue work through to the end of August. COVID safety protocols are in place for these jobs.

You will gain four months of hands-on experience, open doors and build transferable skills for your future career.

Responsibilities of the Water and Wastewater Student will include, but not be limited to:

- General maintenance including; Painting, manual labour, grass cutting and trimming.
- Assisting with hydrant and valve maintenance, manual labour associated with moving materials, clean-up of facilities and yards.
- Assist with data entry, file maintenance, speaking with internal and external contacts on the phone or in person.
- Monitoring hauled sewage treatment locations and reporting on activity.

The skills, experience and qualifications we are seeking for this job include:

- Students must be enrolled in full-time post-secondary studies for the following school year.
- Preference given to students with Operator in Training certificates and/ or those enrolled in Environmental, Civil or related Engineering programs
- Ability to work well with minimal supervision
- A valid Ontario Driver's License (minimum G2) is required for this role as you will be driving District vehicles.
