# We're making a clear commitment to waste reduction

## Muskoka's Clear Bag Program

encourages conscious waste sorting to extend the life of our only landfill and boost diversion efforts. Started in March 2025 for curbside collection and 2026 at District Waste Facilities, non-compliant garbage bags will not be collected or accepted without charge.

Using clear bags improves recycling, diverts organics, conserves landfill space, protects workers from hazards, and keeps dangerous items—like batteries, paint, medicines, and fuel—out of the waste stream, supporting a safer, more sustainable Muskoka.

# Recycle more than ever before

**No matter where you are in Ontario — at home, the cottage, or just passing through — recycling is now even simpler and more consistent.** The province's enhanced recycling system means you'll be able to recycle the same materials everywhere, and even more materials right at the curb.

With the launch of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) across Ontario, producers are now fully responsible for funding and managing the collection and recycling of packaging and paper materials.

## What does this mean for you?

- **Consistency across the province:** A standardized recycling system, no matter where you live.
- **More materials accepted:** Recycle items like toothpaste tubes, deodorant sticks, ice cream tubs, black plastic containers, and frozen juice containers.
- **A stronger circular economy:** Collected recyclables are sorted and processed so they can be reused again and again — returning to your home as new products or packaging.

This new system is managed by Circular Materials, a not-for-profit organization and the administrator of Ontario's common collection system, committed to building efficient and effective recycling programs across the province.

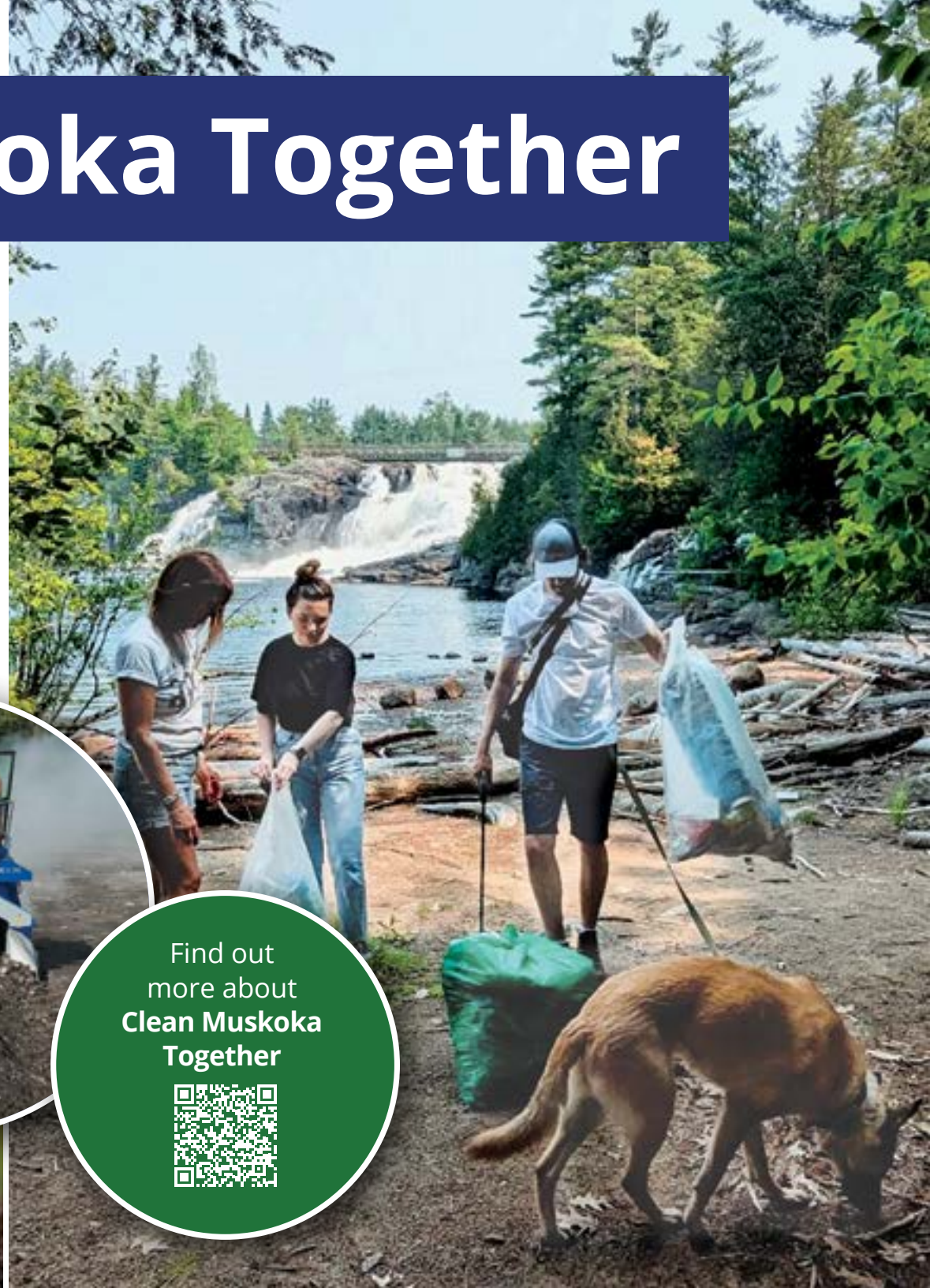


# Clean Muskoka Together

# Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)



HHW includes toxic, flammable, corrosive, or reactive items like paint, cleaners, pesticides, batteries, and fuels. Improper disposal harms people and the environment. Municipalities manage HHW with programs to keep hazardous materials out of landfills and ensure safe, responsible waste management.

Muskoka residents can drop off residential hazardous waste, for free, at scheduled events or in Bracebridge at:

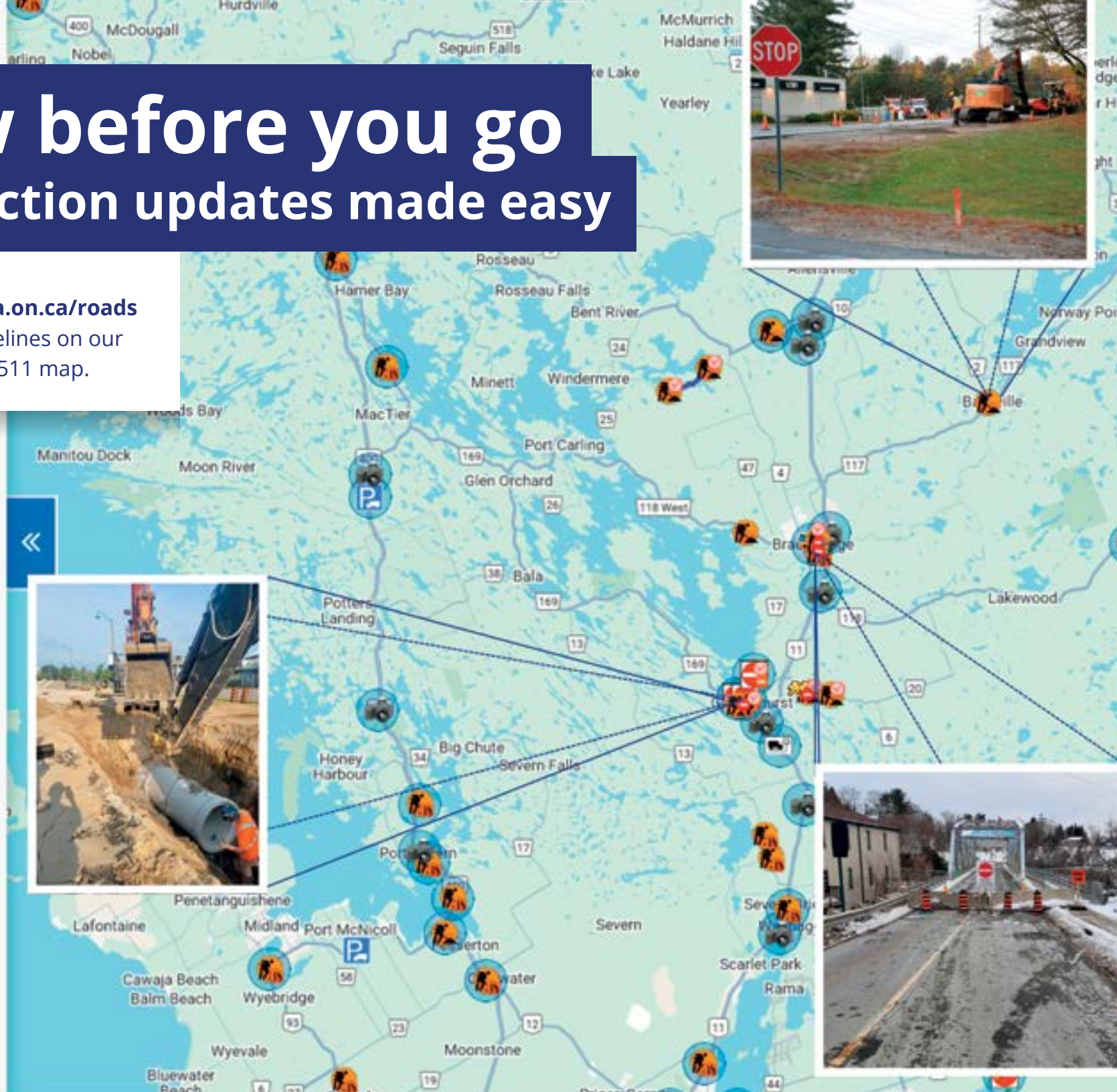

# Electronic Waste (E-Waste) Disposal



**Protect Muskoka—  
manage e-waste safely.**

Electronic devices contain hazardous materials like mercury and lead that can harm our environment. E-waste is not collected at the curb and must be disposed of responsibly.

Many electronics can be returned to manufacturers, or dropped off free of charge at the listed local transfer stations:

- Bracebridge - Rosewarne Transfer Station, 1062 Rosewarne Dr.
- Gravenhurst - Beiers Road Transfer Station, 1052 Beiers Rd.
- Huntsville - Stisted Transfer Station, 178 Stisted Landfill Rd.
- Muskoka Lakes - Eveleigh Transfer Station, 1174 Eveleigh Rd.
- Lake of Bays - Franklin Transfer Station, 1020 Oxtongue Rapids Rd.
- Georgian Bay - Baxter Transfer Station, 980 South Bay Rd.

# Extreme Weather Tips

**Severe weather can throw a wrench into the dump run.** Blowing snow, icy roads, and high winds can affect operations at District Waste Facilities. Staff work hard to clear snow, sand and salt—but truly nasty weather means safety comes first.

Bad weather? Delay your trip, combine errands on a better day, or store your waste securely until conditions improve.

## Before you go, do a quick check:

- If you can't see the end of your driveway, it's probably not dump-day weather.
- Check road and weather conditions.
- Confirm your local site is open and operating normally.

For updates on closures, delayed openings, or early shutdowns, check our Waste App and municipal website, changes are posted quickly so you don't arrive to find a locked gate.

Thanks for your patience and understanding when storms roll in. ***Planning ahead and staying informed, keeps you and others safe—no matter what the forecast throws at us.***
