- Discussion on landfill design, membrane technology, size of cells & life expectancy – Rosewarne west is a 14.85 hectare landfill footprint on 35.8 hectare property. (For reference, the old landfill across the road is 6.45 hectares on 20.8 hectares of land).
- Government standards changing, increasing diversion of organics – possibly commercial?
- Redirecting some large commercial materials (ie culverts), recycling shingles
- Current DMM diversion rate 47%
- Variable models for disposal of waste in Muskoka, based on Town/Twp wishes/needs (full program curbside collection, depots, bin sites, transfer stations). Services run on a charge back system to respective Towns/Townships
- Leachate collection and testing
- What's next? Planning for a new landfill to accommodate future needs.

- PLC meeting schedule – consideration to committee and council meetings. Perhaps PLC meetings should be scheduled prior to committee meetings.
- Expectation of PLC – ECA requirement, defining role & responsibility
- What is the vehicle for communication with the public – consultant reports etc?
