Are you experiencing homelessness?

Experiencing homelessness might look a little different from person to person and could include one or more of the following living situations:

- Living **unsheltered** (e.g., living outside, in vehicles, tents, or camps)
- Using **emergency shelters** (e.g., staying in temporary shelters or motels)
- **Hidden homeless** (e.g. staying with friends or family, couch surfing, etc.)
- Using **temporary accommodation** (e.g., staying in a hospital, or residential treatment, or correctional institution without having a home to go to when discharged)

As part of the Nationally Coordinated Point-in-Time Counts of Homelessness in Canada, the District of Muskoka is conducting a homelessness survey to better understand the needs of individuals and families facing homelessness in our community.
