

Mountview Forcemain Phase 2B

The District of Muskoka is beginning construction on the next phase of the Mountview Forcemain Project. This phase includes installing new underground sanitary forcemain infrastructure from Coveside Drive to the Golden Pheasant Wastewater Treatment Plant. The forcemain will be constructed within the boulevard along Highway 60.

Construction is scheduled to begin by mid-September, with Part A of the forcemain installation, from Allison Point Road to Grandview Forest Hill, expected to be completed by the end of November 2026, and Part B anticipated to be completed by the end of November 2027.

To ensure the safety of workers and the public, temporary single lane closures on Highway 60 will occur throughout construction. Access to all homes and businesses will remain open at all times. No lane closures will occur on Friday afternoons, weekends, or statutory holidays, and all lanes will be fully opened at the end of each workday.

This project is part of the District's investment in critical infrastructure that supports housing growth and will expand wastewater capacity to enable new homes in the Town of Huntsville.

Work Details

The construction work for this project includes:

- Installation of sanitary forcemain by trenchless and open cut methods.
- Site restorations for impacted areas.

What to Expect During Construction



Construction Impacts:

- Increased noise, vibrations, and dust from construction activities.
- Construction vehicles entering and leaving the site.
- Intermittent, temporary single-lane closures on Highway 60 within the construction limits.



Work Hours:

- Work will take place Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., although crew members may not necessarily be on site for the full length of those hours each day.



Getting Around:

- Intermittent, temporary single-lane closures will take place along Highway 60 throughout construction.
- Access to all businesses and residences within the project area will be maintained throughout construction.
- Emergency services, school boards, waste collection providers, and other key partners have been consulted to ensure continuity of service.

As with any construction project, dates and durations are subject to change due to weather, supply availability, or other unforeseen circumstances. The District is committed to minimizing disruption wherever possible.
