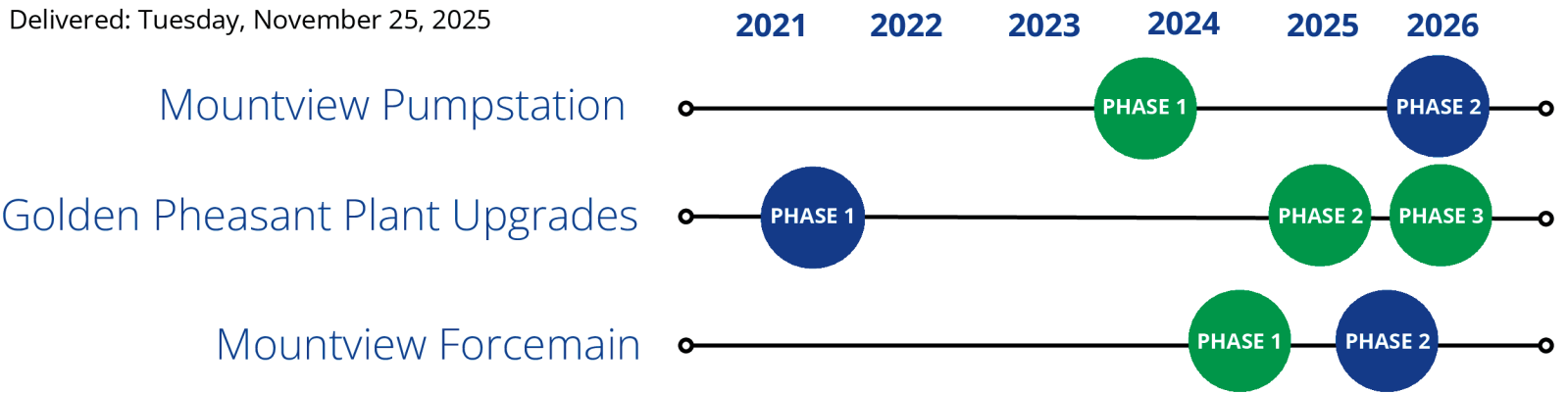

Mountview Pumpstation Update

Officially above ground

The Mountview Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) project is nearing completion. The building is fully constructed with mechanical and electrical equipment currently being installed with project completion expected for Spring 2026.

Golden Pheasant Update

Phase 2 and 3 are currently underway!

Construction for the expansion of the Golden Pheasant wastewater plant is currently underway working towards doubling the capacity of the wastewater treatment plant to accept the sanitary sewage flow being diverted from the upcoming decommissioning of the Mountview wastewater plant.

Completion of the upgrades are expected to be completed late 2026.

Forcemain Update

Phase 1 is now complete!

Mountview Forcemain Phase 2 A is currently underway with expected completion in June 2026. The work being completed starting at the intersection of Scott and Meadow Park to Rogers Cove.

Mountview Forcemain Phase 2 B will include work from Rogers Cove to Golden Pheasant Water and Wastewater plant and is expected to start April 2026.

We continue to focus on critical infrastructure upgrades while improving area aesthetics.

Road work ahead: Here’s how to navigate it

Project closures and detours:

There will be small single lane closures at drilling/connection points. Expect delays up to 5 minutes.

Pedestrian access:

Sidewalk access could be impacted in areas on Meadow Park

Waste collection

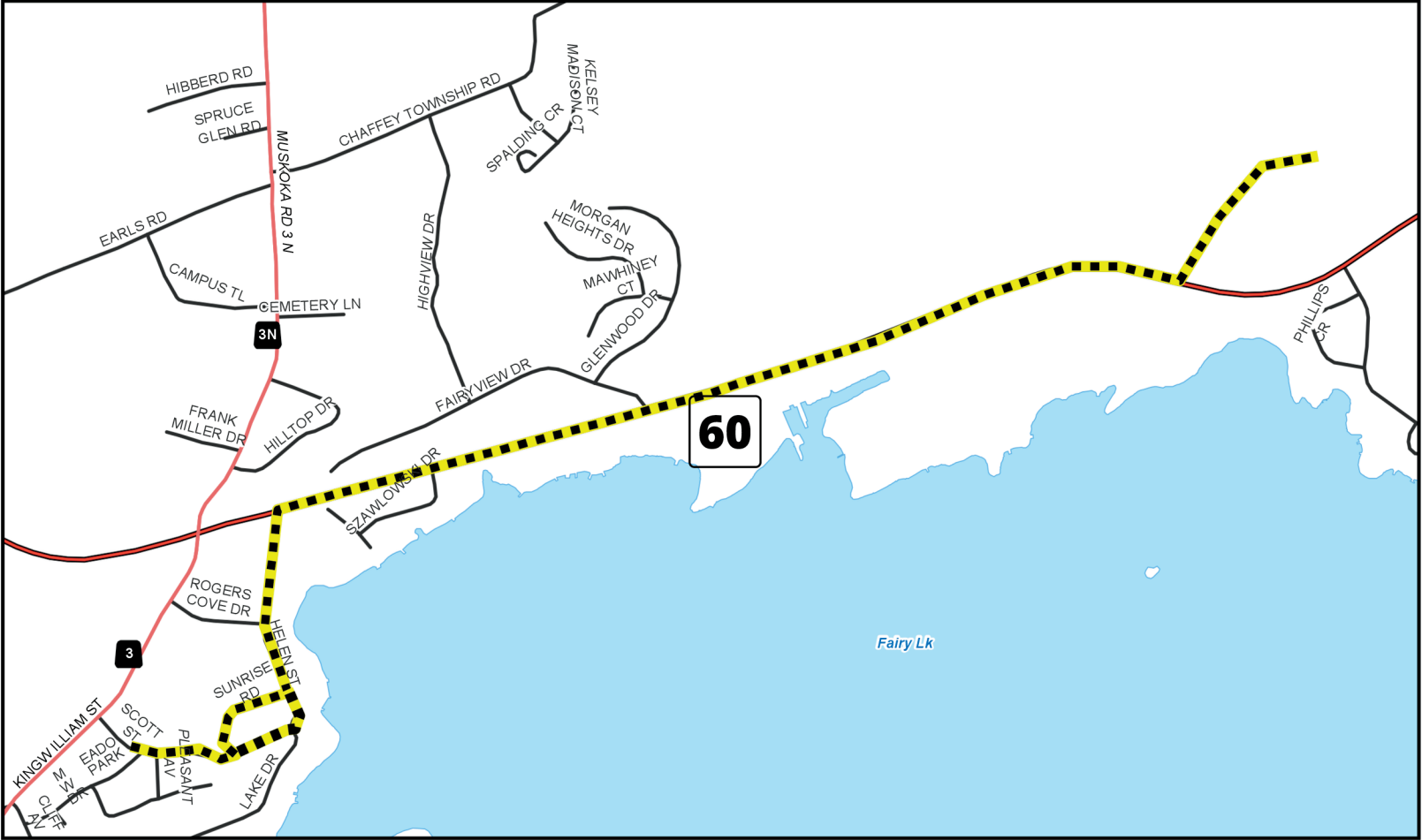
The project team is working closely with waste partners to ensure there are no disruptions to collection. Curbside collection will continue as normal for eligible properties and collection days remain the same. Collection starts at 7 a.m.

Emergency Services

The project team has been working with emergency services partners to ensure priority access is available throughout the construction zones so they can continue to support our community.
